The Scholarship will provide one \$1,000 scholarship annually to a member of the United Methodist congregation within the bounds of the North Georgia Annual Conference who is enrolled or enrolling as a full-time student in UM University Senate approved seminary in Georgia. The applicant's goal must be to be an Ordained Minister in the North Georgia Annual Conference. The applicant must be in the candidacy process supervised by the North Georgia Annual Conference Board of Ordained Ministry.

The following information must accompany this application before the scholarship can be considered:

1. Documentation of enrollment as a full-time student in an accredited Georgia United Methodist seminary; and
2. Documentation that the student is in the candidacy process from your District Superintendent; and
3. A statement about applicant's call to and vision of ordained ministry (no more than two typed pages).
